

Washington State Medical Gas Brazer
Record of Continuity

The Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 18.106 requires journeymen plumbers holding an active medical gas installation state endorsement to complete an affidavit of continuity every six months. This continuity verifies that the certified medical gas installer has performed an acceptable braze. This record of continuity is kept by United Association Local 32 (UA Local 32) authorized officials.

The record of continuity must be provided to the Washington State Department of Labor & Industries (LNI) at the time of endorsement renewal. This renewal must be done every two years on or before your birthday; failure to renew within 90 days will result in suspension and require re-testing.

The card holder must have completed an LNI-approved, 32 hour training course.

Renewal of qualification is required when a brazer or braze operator has not performed a medical gas braze for a period of 6 months or more, or if there is a specific reason to question the ability to make brazes that meet state specifications.
