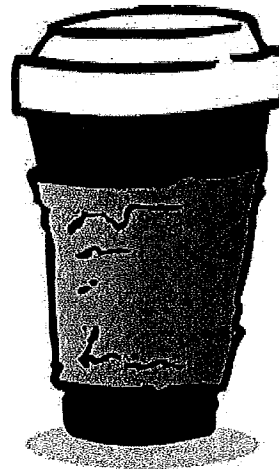
**When:** 9:00 a.m. – Noon – Saturday January 28th; we will meet back starting at 12:15 to collect back walking lists and information
